In the name of God Amen I Tabitha Davis of the county of N^oampton and state of North Carolina being weak in body but of Sound and Disposing mind and memory do this 17th of Dec. in the year of our Lord 1832 make this to be my last will and testament in manner and form following.

Item 1st I Give and bequeath unto my daughter Cherry Stephenson one Dollar to her and her heirs forever.

Item 2nd I Give and bequeath unto my son Sterling Davis one Dollar to him and his Heirs forever.

Item 3rd I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sally Britton one Dollar to her and her Heirs forever.

Item 4th I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Gincy Martin one Dollar to her and her Heirs forever.

Item 5th I Give and bequeath unto my Son Wilkerson Davis one Dollar to him and his Heirs forever.

Item 6th I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Rebecca Deloach one Dollar to her and her heirs forever.

Item 7th I Give and bequeath unto my daughter Tabitha Lassiter one dollar to her and her heirs forever.

Item 8th I Give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth H. Madry one dollar to her and her heirs forever.

Item 9th I Give and bequeath to my Son Hillery Davis after paying off all my just Debts the balance of my Estate of Every Kind whatsoever in possession or reversion or remainder to him and his heirs Forever.

Lastly I nominate and appoint my son Hillery Davis my whole and sole Executor to this my Last will and testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this day and date Above mentioned. Signed sealed and acknowledged testatrix in presents of
